The Big Idea

Is 'Growth Stock' a Misnomer?



Who He Is: Assistant Finance Professor Sean Myers' paper, "The Return of Return Dominance: Decomposing the Cross-section of Prices," co-authored by Ricardo De la O and Xiao Han, won the Rodney L. White Center's 2022 Marshall Blume First Prize in financial

research and the 2023 Best Paper from the Jacobs Levy Center.

What's The Story: In an interview with Finance at Wharton, Myers discusses the attention his 2022 paper has garnered and how his research might affect the way people think about long-term investing.

What Do The Experts Say: "Our work reinforces the idea that stock fundamentals are a large determinant of long-term returns. Short-term returns may be influenced by momentum or swings between 'risk on' and 'risk off' investor sentiment."

What's The Takeaway: According to Myers' award-winning paper, stocks prices differ between companies because they differ in earnings growth. But stocks with higher price-to-earnings ratios, known as "growth stocks," ironically have lower long-term returns than others.
